

## Covidien to Pay Over \$17 Million to The United States for Allegedly Providing Illegal Remuneration in the Form of Practice and Market Development Support to Physicians

Covidien LP has agreed to pay \$17,477,947 to resolve allegations that it violated the False Claims Act by providing free or discounted practice development and market development support to physicians located in California and Florida to induce purchases of Covidien's vein ablation products, the Department of Justice announced today.

"Today's settlement serves as an important reminder to those in the health care community that unlawful kickbacks come in many forms and are not limited to monetary payments to providers," said Assistant Attorney General Jody Hunt for the Department of Justice's Civil Division. "Providing free or discounted services to health care providers to induce the use of certain items or services can lead to excessive and unnecessary treatments, and drive up health care costs for everyone."

"Patients in federal health care programs deserve medical care that is free from improper financial incentives," said U.S. Attorney David L. Anderson for the Northern District of California. "As this case makes clear, companies must steer clear of

### Drug Company Manager Admits Role in Kickback Scheme Related to Fentanyl Spray Prescriptions

John H. Durham, United States Attorney for the District of Connecticut, announced that JEFFREY PEARLMAN, 51, of Edgewood, N.J., pleaded guilty today before U.S. District Judge Janet Bond Arterton in New Haven to engaging in a kickback scheme that defrauded federal healthcare programs.

According to court documents and statements made in court, from approximately September 2012 until November 2015, PEARLMAN was employed by Insys Therapeutics, an Arizona-based pharmaceutical company that manufactured and sold Subsys, a fentanyl-based sublingual spray that was approved by the Food and Drug Administration solely for the management of breakthrough pain in cancer patients. ### Former Physician Assistant Convicted In Kickback Scheme

**Concord -** United States Attorney Scott W. Murray announced that a federal jury found Christopher Clough, 44, of Dover, New Hampshire guilty of participating in a scheme in which he received kickbacks in exchange for prescribing a powerful fentanyl spray to patients in violation of federal law.

According to testimony during the trial, which began on December 11, 2018, Clough worked as a physician assistant in New Hampshire. After being approached by a representative of a drug manufacturer in June of 2013, he became a frequent prescriber of a fentanyl spray that had been approved by the Food and Drug Administration to treat breakthrough cancer pain. From approximately June of 2013 through the fall of 2014, Clough wrote more than 750 prescriptions for the fentanyl spray in New



#### **Dataset Downloads**

#### Before you download

Some datasets, particularly the general payments dataset included in these zip files, are extremely large and may be burdensome to download and/or cause computer performance issues. Downloading the files with the assistance of the Akamai Download Manager application should make downloading the data easier by offering the option to pause and restart downloading to minimize resource allocation impact. Be advised that the file size, once downloaded, may still be prohibitive if you are not using a robust data viewing application. Microsoft Excel has limitations on the number of records it can display, which this file exceeds. CMS recommends against using Windows File Compression to decompress downloaded files. Programs recommended for file decompression are WinZip, WinRAR, and 7-Zip.

## **SUPPORT ACT**



- <u>Substance Use-Disorder Prevention that Promotes Opioid Recovery and Treatment for Patients and Communities Act</u>
- Signed by President Trump on Oct. 24, 2018
- Section 6111 (Fighting the Opioid Epidemic with Sunshine)
- Effective Jan. 1, 2022 (but tracking will need to begin Jan. 1, 2021)
- Adds tracking for additional provider types (Physician assistants, Nurse practitioners, Clinical nurse specialists, Certified registered nurse anesthetists, and Certified nurse-midwives.)
- Allows CMS to post National Provider Identifier numbers (NPIs) on the public database, something that was previously barred by the Sunshine Act.

- 11.9 million records (2015), less than 1% were missing required data elements.
- OIG did identify records that contained inaccurate, imprecise, or inconsistent information (records containing drug and device names that do not match the definitions of these data elements; NDCs that were not found in FDA databases or other drug information resources; and payment dates from a different reporting year.
- CMS also reported that it is still compiling a list of noncompliant manufacturers and group purchasing organizations for further investigation.

## OIG Report



#### OIG Recommended to CMS:

- ensure that records contain all required data;
- strengthen validation rules and revise data-element definitions so that actual drug and device names must be reported
- revise the definition of the device-name data element so that the information reported is required to be more specific
- ensure that manufacturers and group purchasing organizations report valid NDCs for drugs.

CMS concurred with all four of OIG's recommendations.
