## The opioid epidemic by the numbers – 2016 and 2017 data



People died every day from opioid-related drug overdoses<sup>3</sup>



People misused prescription opioids1

### How we are addressing the opioid epidemic


### System wide assessment

## Provider engagement and community partnership

Working with legislators at local, state and national level to influence policy and guidelines

- Stop Act: passed in July 2017 by NC legislators around prescriptions
- Conducting media interviews to help educate the public
- Partnered with NC Medical Board on CME for appropriate opioid prescribing
- Collaborated on a position paper with the NC Institute of Medicine
- Providing expertise for statewide consultations of pregnant patients

Inpatient medical detox program at Prince William Medical Center considered "gold standard" and model
